1999, PAPER, 288 PAGES, \$29.95

Packed with color photos and maps, this guide includes a section devoted to the formation of the Rockies (with diagrams), fascinating sidebars on wildlife and historical figures, and a handy reference chapter with "to-do" lists for Banff, Waterton, Yoho, Jasper and Kootenay. (Item no. CND28)
