



## THE DESTINATION

Located on the border of Argentina and Brazil, Iguazu Falls is the largest waterfall system in the world. While the Argentine side immerses you in the falls, the Brazilian side offers the best panoramic views. Crossing from one side to the other is not difficult and is actually recommended. Our journey allows you to do both and fully experience the beauty of this natural wonder. You'll walk along Iguazu's impressive collection of waterfalls and feel the mist from the stunning Garganta del Diablo. Surrounded by tropical jungle and home to incredible biodiversity, Iguazu Falls offers a sense of perfect harmony with nature.

## THE JOURNEY

### Day 1: Puerto Iguazu

Welcome to Iguazu! The small and relaxing town is the gateway to visit the impressive Iguazu Falls, recently named as one of the New Seven Natural Wonders of the World and a must-see destination for any traveler visiting Argentina.

Upon arrival, you are met at the airport by your guide and provided a private transfer to your hotel inside Iguazu Falls to check in.

This afternoon, you enjoy a private, half-day excursion to the Brazilian side of Iguazu Falls. Here, vast panoramic views allow you to gaze in awe at the falls in their entirety and begin to understand their sheer size and power from a distance. If your flight arrives later in the day, this activity may be rescheduled for the morning of Day 3.

## Day 2: Iguazu National Park

Your guide will meet you in the lobby after breakfast, and from there, you explore the hidden gems of this unique national park on foot.

Lower and upper walkways along the falls offer up-close and personal experiences with this magnificent sight. Trails throughout the reserve provide visitors with various views of Iguazu Falls, especially the largest one, Devil's Throat. The Ecological Jungle Train is included for all those visiting the park and will allow you to move from one area to the next.

Once inside the park, additional excursions are available for an additional cost. The most popular option is "Gran Aventura," which begins with a short overland drive through the rainforest as you learn about the flora and fauna. Upon arrival at a dock, you board a boat, which takes you right up to the base of the falls! This exciting excursion is highly-recommended in order to experience the true power of Iguazu Falls and costs \$50 per person. You will get wet! We recommend bringing a change of clothes if you would like to join this adventure.

This evening, you are transferred back to your hotel to relax and dine at your leisure.

## Day 3: Departure

## TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

This extension may be scheduled either before or after your Argentina trip. If scheduled before, the flight will be a morning flight to Iguazu from Buenos Aires and can be booked to accommodate your arrival flight from the US, if you wish to travel directly to Iguazu. (Flight time is approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes.) If you prefer to spend a night in Buenos Aires prior to the extension, this is an option as well, and your flight to Iguazu will depart the next morning. Your return will be mid-day three days later, and will be scheduled to accommodate meeting the group on Day 1. If scheduled after the trip, your flight to Iguazu would depart on the morning of Day 10 of your trip, and your return will be an evening flight departure to the US.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

U.S. passport holders must obtain a Brazilian visa prior to travel. The Brazilian consulate offers an easy-to-use online “evisa” process through the following website:

The cost for an evisa is \$40, plus an approximate 10% service charge, for a total cost of about \$44.25. Once you



have registered on the site below and provide the requested information and visa payment, you will receive an email, typically within 5 days, with your evisa, which must be printed and carried with you to enter Brazil.

## GRATUITIES

While gratuities are entirely at your discretion, the following guidelines (in USD) are fairly standard for Argentina: \$10-20 per person per day for guides, \$5-10 per person per day for drivers, \$3-5 per day for housekeeping, \$2-3 per service for porters, and 10% of dining bills.

## WEATHER

Iguazu Falls is located near the equator and has a year-round tropical climate making it an excellent destination to visit any time of year. The warmest weather occurs during the summer months of December through March. Given the tropical climate, rain can occur at any time.
